TRAP SHOOT INFORMATION

WELCOME!

SAFETY IS EVERYONE'S RESPONSIBLITY:

- Keep the muzzle pointed in a safe direction.
- Keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.
- Keep the gun unloaded until ready to use.
- Know your target and what is beyond.
- Actions must be open and the shotgun <u>empty of ammunition at all times</u>, except in preparation to shoot.
- Pump and semi-auto shotguns shall be carried with the muzzle pointed up. Break-action shotguns may have their actions closed while in the shotgun rack.
- When shooting: load one (1) shell at a time and do not reload until just before you're ready to shoot again.

(located approx. 1.5 miles West of Rifle & Pistol Main Range)

TEAM ARRIVAL & CHECK-IN

- Upon arrival, please leave shotguns in your vehicles until your assigned trap has been confirmed at Check-In.
- Please arrive approximately **30 MINUTES PRIOR** to your scheduled start time. If you are renting a shotgun from Ben Avery and/or would like to visit our practice range, consider arriving **1 HOUR** prior to your start time.
- Of course, we hope you'll come early and stay a little later for the networking, practice range, food, music and more!

SHOTGUNS & AMMUNITION

- LIMITED GUN RENTALS available on site this year through Ben Avery Clay Target Center.
- Your are <u>STRONGLY ENCOURAGED</u> to bring your own or a borrowed shotgun as Ben Avery cannot guarantee rental availability.
- Sharing of shotguns between shooters of the same team is prohibited.
- Only shotguns are permitted at the CTC. Shotguns may not be larger than 12-gauge and barrel lengths may not be shorter than 18½ inches.
- HomeAid Phoenix will supply <u>12-gauge ammunition only</u> for all registered shooters. If you choose to utilize a different gauge, you are responsible for supplying your own ammunition.
- Lead shot only not larger than 7½ and loads greater than 3¼ dram equivalent may be used, no magnum loads. Buckshot, turkey loads, rifled slugs, steel shot, etc. are not permitted.
- Closed-toe shoes required and hats recommended.

WHAT'S INCLUDED

- Registration includes: trap fees, 50 clay targets, 50 rounds of 12-gauge ammunition only (If you choose to utilize a different gauge, you are responsible for supplying your own ammunition), new eye and ear protection, lunch and refreshments.
- All shooters will shoot a total of 50 shots each.
- After the first set of 25 shots have been taken, shooters will restock ammunition and continue with next 25.
- Teams will be scheduled in single 60-minute blocks; with staggered starting times.

SAFETY IS EVERYONE'S RESPONSIBLITY

- Actions must be open and the shotgun empty of ammunition at all times, except in preparation to shoot.
- Pump and semi-auto shotguns shall be carried with the muzzle pointed up.
- Break-action shotguns may have their actions closed while in the shotgun rack.
- When shooting, load only one (1) shell at a time and do not reload until just before you're ready to shoot again.
